Roundtable and health check

- ATO / ABSIA round table held fortnightly
- ABSIA health check to be delivered to ATO bi-monthly – first in March

Health check

Performance testing and production environments

- some gains with Amazon Web Services
- SBR core (SBR₁) still outperforming ATO ebMS₃ (SBR₂) – in some cases by up to five times the speed in completing a transaction

Health check - continued

Issues and incidents

- prioritisation process in place but is still being refined
- some issues currently set at low severity may prove to cause difficulty for Tax Agents
- issues and incidents are being resolved but not at the same rate as developers expect from ELS

Health check - continued

Account managers

- satisfaction high from developers
- could they be used more effectively in prioritisation processes of issues and incidents
