We were previously known as the Australian Business Software Industry Association (ABSIA) and have played a central role in the development of many key digital initiatives:

- ELS to SBR
- SuperStream
- Digital Service Provider Operational Framework
- Peppol e-invoicing
- Security Standard for Add-on Marketplaces
- ANZ Industry Practice Statements.

In 2021 we established a presence in NZ and rebranded to better serve and reflect our trans-Tasman membership.



# **Our work with government**

We currently co-chair three prominent industry working groups:

- Australian Taxation Office's DSP Strategic Working Group (SWG)
  - Working with the Digital Partnership Office on policy and projects directly affecting DSPs. 1-2 joint DSPANZ and SWG meetings each year.
- Department of Employment and Workplace Relations RegTech Award Compliance Strategic Working Group (RACSWG)
  - Working with the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations, Fair Work Commission, Fair Work Ombudsman and DSPANZ members offering award compliance software and services.
- New Zealand Digital Advisory Group (NZ DAG)
   Working with the Inland Revenue Department and tax, accounting and payroll providers on policy and projects directly affecting DSPs.











