EmployTech Industry Committee

Charter Document

Purpose

The EmployTech Industry Committee focuses on the different pieces of technology that an employer uses to manage and pay their employees. At a high level this includes:

- Payroll (including Single Touch Payroll)
- Fair Work compliance
- Rostering, time and attendance (RTA)
- Human Resources (HR)

The purpose of this Committee is to work collaboratively with both the Government and our members to help shape the future of these services and the overall EmployTech landscape.

Background

Historically, DSPANZ and our members have played a central role in the development of the Single Touch Payroll program of work and we continue to be heavily involved in the payroll space.

More recently, DSPANZ has engaged with the Fair Work Commission on their Modern Awards Pay (MAP) Database and the Attorney-General's Department on creating the industry co-chaired RegTech Award Compliance Strategic Working Group (RACSWG).

DSPANZ also Co-Chairs the New Zealand Digital Advisory Group (NZ DAG) which has a payroll working group with DSPANZ member representation.

Objectives

The main objectives (subject to the capacity of Committee members) of this group include:

- Drive relationships with key government stakeholders in the EmployTech space and provide a channel for them to work with DSPs on relevant projects
- Partner with the Attorney-General's Department on the outcomes of their Regulatory Technology Roadmap
- Assist DSPANZ members with understanding and planning for current and future changes to payroll and award compliance
- Support DSPANZ members and government on the ongoing Single Touch Payroll program

- Providing an open and safe platform (where anonymity is respected) for DSPANZ members to discuss, provide feedback and raise concerns

Participants

This Committee is a committee of the Board (i.e. it is not a Member's Committee as defined in the Constitution). Committee members can be either DSPANZ Directors or DSPANZ members. Membership of the Committee is reviewed annually and members can express their interest in joining the Committee.

Membership will be sought from members that are interested and involved in payroll, award compliance etc. within their organisations to support the work of the Committee. Committee members are asked to represent the industry, not solely their business while taking part in and representing this Committee. The Committee may appoint additional members as required.

At the first meeting of each year, the Committee will appoint one or two of the members as Chair(s) of the Committee. One of these members must be a DSPANZ Director.
